



## SHREWSBURY ASC SPRING OPEN MEET LEVEL 2 LICENSED MEET

For entry into Regional and National Competitions

**SATURDAY 6th April 2013**

Under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules

(Affiliated to Shropshire County ASA and West Midlands ASA)

### **Promoter's Conditions. This event is designated by the ASA for entry into Regional and National Competitions.**

1. All entrants must be registered members of their Association and of an affiliated Club, and amateurs as defined by ASA Laws.
2. Entries must be correctly completed electronically or on entry forms (photocopies accepted) provided by SASC and accompanied by correct entry fee per event (ASA levy of 25p per entry included). **Ages as at 6<sup>th</sup> April 2013**
3. A competitor may enter all events for which he or she qualifies. **Entry fees are as follows:- all events except 400m £4.50; 400m events £5**
4. The promoter reserves the right to refuse an entry. Incorrect, incomplete or illegible entries and entries without the correct fees will not be accepted. Entries are accepted on the understanding that the competitor accepts the Promoter's Conditions. Swimmers I/D Numbers **MUST** be shown on the entry form.
5. The slowest entries within the qualifying times may be rejected at the discretion of the promoter if the event is oversubscribed
6. Acceptances and refunds will be advised by email. Refunds will be made available for collection on day of meet – please await announcement.
7. Entries received after the Closing Date may not be accepted. No refunds will be made to competitors who withdraw after advice of acceptance.
8. **The Meet will run without entry cards. Withdrawals must be posted no later than 45 minutes before the start of the session. It will be the responsibility of coaches to ensure that their swimmers are fully aware of this arrangement.**
9. Clubs may have a maximum of three poolside managers (coaches) who will be admitted on production of a pass at a cost of £6.00 each (available for collection on day), which will include programme. Poolside managers **must** provide evidence of CRB check when collecting passes.
10. All events will be “single start”.
11. **All events will be Heat Declared Winner**
12. The order of the events may be changed at the discretion of the referee.
13. Entries will be seeded into heats from submitted times, with the slowest heat first. **Final heat will be spearheaded**
14. Awards will be given to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each dual age group (i.e 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16, 17+), Top Boy, Top Girl in each dual age group with most BAGCAT points and to the visiting Club with the most points.
14. **Video Recording/Photography/Mobile Telephones**  
In accordance with the recommendations of the ASA Child Protection Policy, any person wishing to engage in video, zoom or close range photography, including the use of mobile telephones with photographic capabilities, must first register their details in the book provided at the spectator entrance desk. They will be provided with an identification label (permit) which must be worn at all times. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse the granting of a permit. **It is requested that all mobile telephones are switched off or switched to silent during the competition and that there is no flash photography at the start of each event.**
15. **Data Protection**  
With the submission of entry details, consent is deemed to have been given, as required of the Data Protection Act, to the holding and distribution, as necessary, of personal information on computer, to enable the running of the Meet.
16. The event is run under ASA Laws and FINA Technical Rules, and any laws or rules not covered by the Promoter's Conditions shall be covered by the ASA Laws on Open Competitions. By submitting an entry participants have deemed to agree to such decisions.
17. The Promoter reserves the right to amend the Conditions, without prior notice, to ensure the smooth running of the Meet.
